By-Laws

SUBJECT: NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Board members are nominated by component districts and elected by a majority vote of all component boards of education. Each component board shall have one vote. No more than one member residing in a particular component district may serve at any one time.

Candidates for vacancies must be nominated by resolution of a Board of Education of a component district. Such nomination must be forwarded to the Clerk of the Board of Cooperative Educational Services at least thirty (30) days prior to the date for election as designated by the President of the BOCES. The Clerk of the BOCES will immediately forward notice of the name and residence address of each person so nominated to the Clerk of each component district by certified mail.

The Clerk of the BOCES will forward an official ballot to the Clerk of each component district at least 14 days prior to the date set for election.

Board members are elected for three-year terms effective July 1.
