SUBJECT: SAFETY CONDITIONS AND PROGRAMS

Every possible precaution will be taken to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors and others present on BOCES property or at school-sponsored events.

The practice of safety will also be considered an integral part of the instructional program through fire prevention and emergency procedures and drills.

Each principal will be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school.

General areas of emphasis in the safety program will include, but not be limited to, in-service training, plant inspection, fire prevention, accident recordkeeping, and emergency procedures and drills.

Eye safety devices are to be made available by the BOCES, on an "actual cost" basis, for the protection of employees, students and visitors, and worn in all appropriate occupational education classes and labs when activities present a potential eye hazard. The District Superintendent or his/her designee will insure that these devices are properly repaired, cleaned and stored to prevent the spread of germs or diseases after individuals use them.
