SUBJECT: CURRICULUM

Curriculum is here defined as all the guided experiences of students, under the direction of the school. The Board of Cooperative Educational Services, recognizing that its programs are an adjunct of the component schools served, intends that these programs correspond to and are in harmony with the curricula of these schools. Therefore, the BOCES curriculum will accommodate the unique needs of the students and the districts being served. Planning, program development and evaluation of the curriculum are necessary for a successful, cooperative service.
