### SUBJECT: OPERATION OF MOTOR-DRIVEN VEHICLES ON DISTRICT PROPERTY

All motor-driven vehicles, including cars, snowmobiles, mini-bikes, motorcycles, and other such vehicles are prohibited from being operated upon school grounds or other BOCES owned areas except for authorized school functions or purposes.

Under section 1670 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, School Districts have the power to regulate the direction of traffic and the speed of motor vehicles and motorcycles and otherwise regulate, restrict or prohibit the movement of motor vehicles and motorcycles on any parking fields, driveways and public ways accessory to any school building playground, park installation or facility, and which are under the jurisdiction of such school district for regulatory and custodial purposes.

Herein given this authority, the Genesee-Wyoming BOCES sets forth the following restrictions on vehicles and traffic:

1. All vehicles in approved traffic areas will abide by a 15 mile per hour speed limit
2. All vehicles will remain on driveway and parking lot (approved areas)
3. Only authorized school vehicles will use the grounds (field) or sidewalk access areas
4. All other vehicle and traffic laws
