SUBJECT: CHILDREN WITH HANDICAPPING CONDITIONS

The Genesee-Livingston-Steuben-Wyoming Board of Cooperative Educational Services recognizes the existence of individual differences in the intellectual, social, emotional and physical development of children attending school in the component districts. In recognizing these differences the Board supports a system of services offered to our component districts for students with handicapping conditions.

Program Accessibility

The Genesee-Livingston-Steuben-Wyoming Board of Cooperative Educational Services affirms its compliance with those sections of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 dealing with program accessibility.

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act prohibits discrimination against qualified students with handicapping conditions in federally assisted programs or activities solely on the basis of handicap. The BOCES shall make its program and facilities accessible to all its students with handicapping conditions.

The District official responsible for coordination of activities relating to compliance with Section 504 is the District's Assistant Superintendent for Instructional Services. This official shall provide information, including complaint procedures, to any person who feels his or her rights under Section 504 have been violated by the District or its officials.
