SUBJECT: AIDS INSTRUCTION IN HEALTH EDUCATION

The Genesee-Livingston-Steuben-Wyoming Board of Cooperative Educational Services shall provide a health education program that will include appropriate instruction for all full-time students concerning Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS). Accurate information concerning the nature of the disease, methods of transmission, and means of prevention shall be provided in an age-appropriate manner and shall be consistent with community values.

Parents/legal guardians shall have the right to exclude their children from those portions of the AIDS instructional program, if they agree in writing to provide instruction at home concerning the prevention of AIDS.

AIDS instruction in the elementary levels (K-6) shall be taught by the classroom teacher, while such instruction in secondary levels (7-12) shall be a part of the required health education course.
